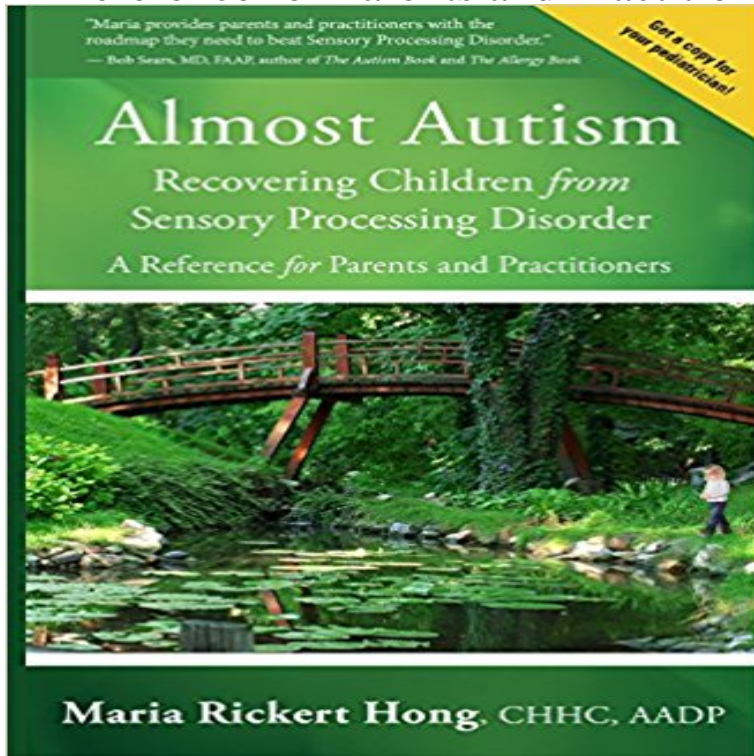


# Almost Autism: Recovering Children from Sensory Processing Disorder: A Reference for Parents and Practitioners
