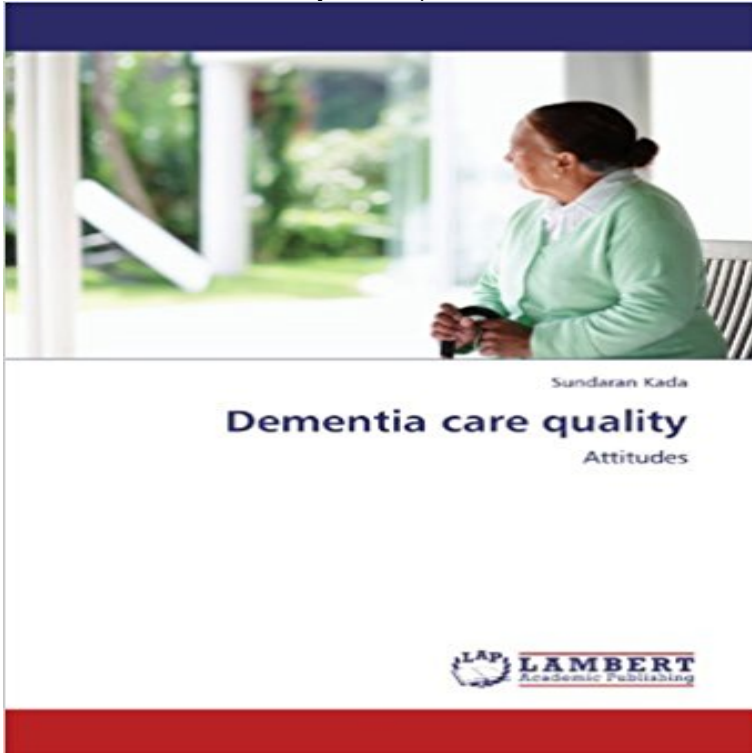


# Dementia care quality: Attitudes
