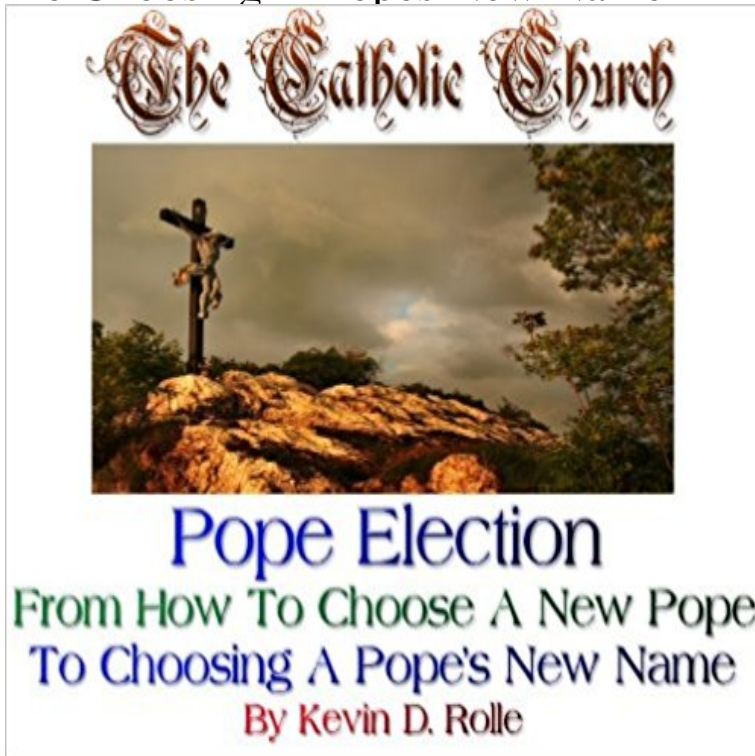


# The Catholic Church Pope Election: From How To Choose A New Pope, To Choosing A Popes New Name
