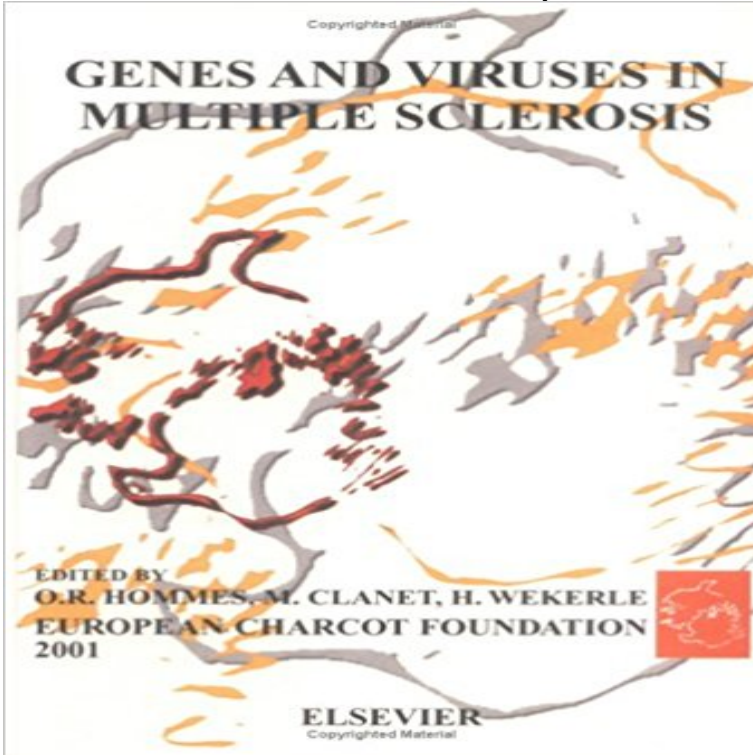


# Genes and Viruses in Multiple Sclerosis
