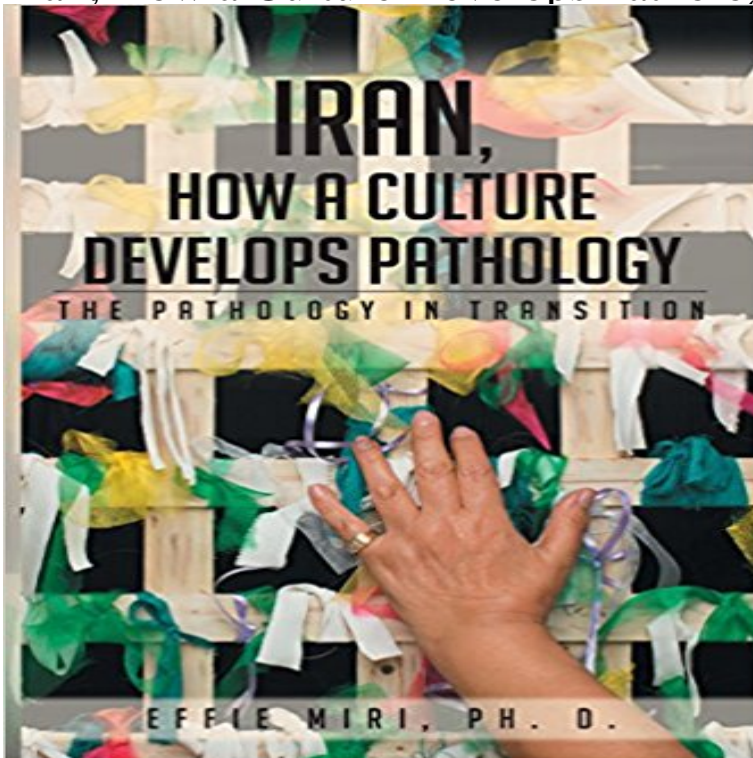


Iran, How a Culture Develops Pathology: The Pathology in Transition
