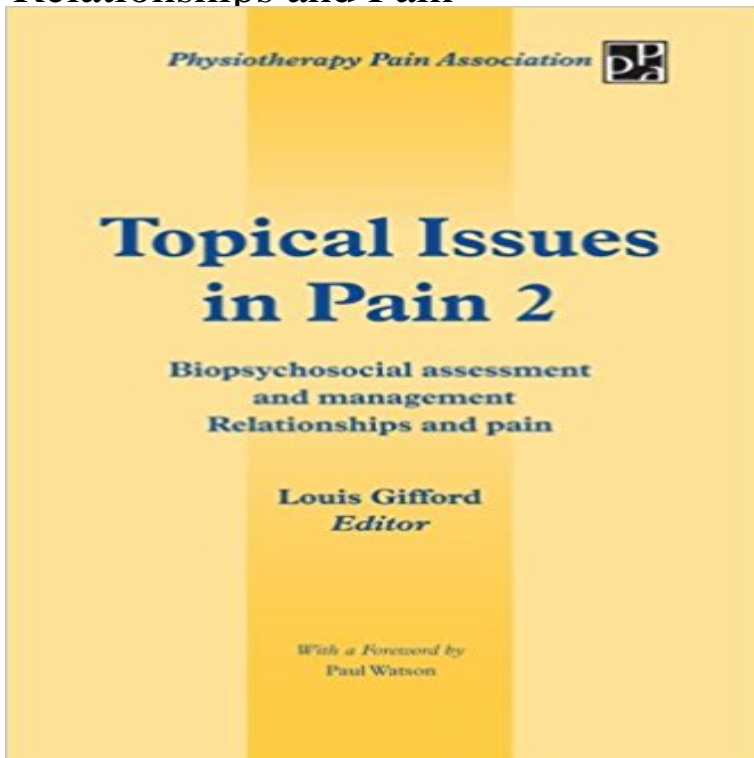


Topical Issues in Pain 2: Biopsychosocial Assessment and Management Relationships and Pain
