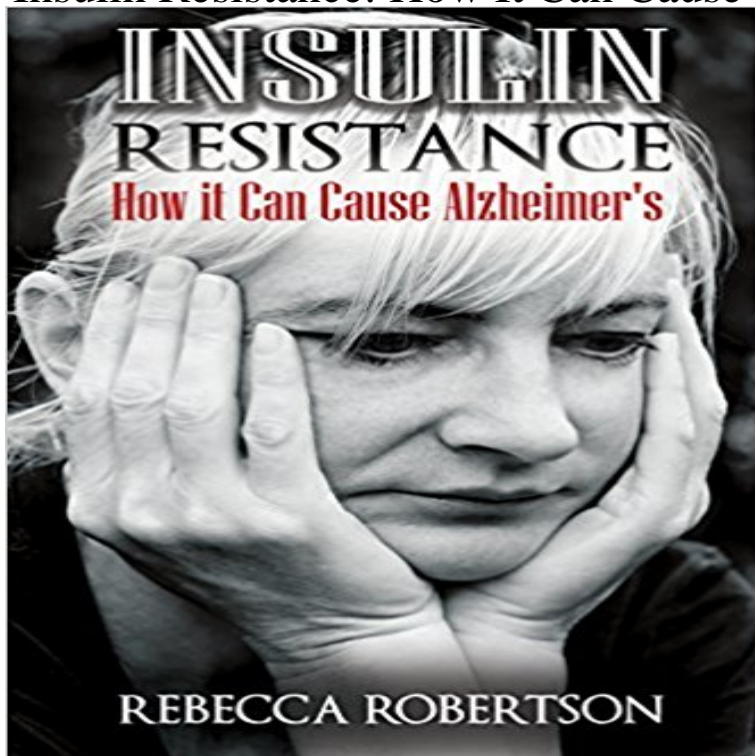


Insulin Resistance: How It Can Cause Alzheimers
