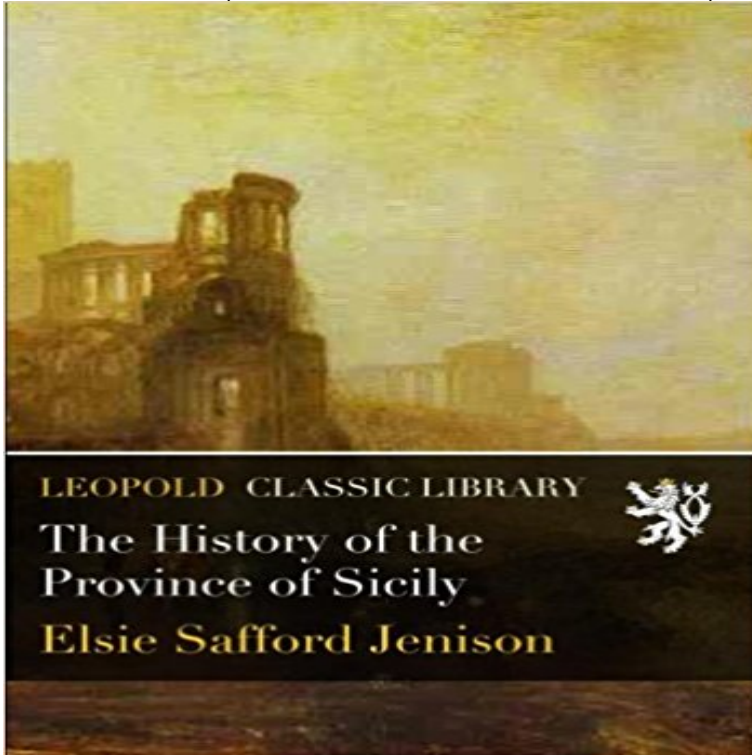


The History of the Province of Sicily
